



Walkthrough Procedure

Students who have not completed all degree or certificate requirements but wish to participate in the Commencement Ceremony, must complete the "walkthrough" portion of the commencement application and meet one of the criteria down below.

To be considered a "walkthrough," students must meet one of the following criteria and not have any "financial holds" on their accounts.

1. You are a master or doctoral student who:
 - Is within 6 credits of completing program requirements, as of the first day of the summer 2018 trimester, or

2. You are a certificate student who:
 - Is within 3 credits of completing program requirements, as of the first day of the summer 2018 trimester

Walkthrough requests will be approved by the Registrar, who will verify that you have met the above criteria. Outstanding non-credit program requirements are not factored into this review, and will not hold students back from participation in the Commencement Ceremony. However, any and all requirements of this nature must be fulfilled prior to receiving a conferred degree, official transcript or any other form of official acknowledgement regarding degree completion from MUIH.

The University allows students the opportunity to walk during commencement, under the guidelines listed above. A walkthrough is not considered a degree candidate, and will not receive a diploma, nor conferred degree transcript until all program requirements and any other outstanding issues have been settled. Furthermore, any and all holds/debts with the University must be settled before students are officially provided the aforementioned documentation of completion.
